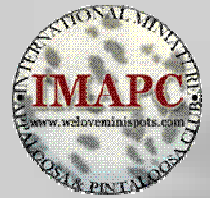

3rd Annual Spotted Stallion Service Auction

The International Miniature Appaloosa and Pinto Club (IMAPC) Members who own visual Appaloosa and Pinto stallions have donated a breeding service to one or more of their stallion(s) to benefit IMAPC. The purpose of IMAPC is easily stated as:

1. To promote the concept and added value of miniature Appaloosa and Pinto patterned horses.
2. To promote the concept that member farms are where to look for quality miniature Appaloosa & Pinto colored horses.
3. To promote, through our breed registries, judging practices in the show ring which give the miniature Appaloosa & Pinto horses equal consideration with all miniature horses.

To this end, IMAPC members are offering this Spotted Stallion Service Auction as a means to promote the production of a correct and balanced registered Appaloosa or Pinto Miniature Horses while maintaining the integrity of the breed, and working to consistently produce well-marked, saleable miniature Appaloosas and Pintos.

How does this sale work?

The Mare Owners/Agent is purchasing and bidding a donated breeding service to a **Registered Mare owned by a Registry Member in good standing**. No purchases/bids will be accepted by a Registry member who is suspended or has been expelled from a Registry.

Each breeding service is offered for sale beginning with **NO BID RESERVE SET—THAT'S RIGHT—NO MINIMUM BID HAS BEEN SET!!!** The Club will then allow increasing bids in \$50.00 increments until the closure of the Auction on **February 28, 2010**. The stallion services showing here are offered to the public at a reduction for this auction only.

BE AWARE: some of these stallions do NOT stand to the general public, and this may be your ONLY time to access some of these fine Appaloosa and Pinto stallion lines!

At the close of the auction each donated breeding is sold to the highest bidder who has 24 hours to make their payment directly to the IMAPC Club by the purchaser. The price of the service includes the breeding service ONLY! All other costs are subject to private negotiation with the stallion owner. These services may include: grazing, mare care, shipping, collection fees, clean culture(s), confirmation of pregnancy, vaccinations, etc.

Stallion service fees will be honored until August 31, 2010.

BEFORE you purchase a breeding, we suggest:

1. Check to make sure the stallion you are interested in located in an area you can access. Remember, our stallions are located across the country, and some are International, and it is **YOUR** responsibility to be sure of the Stallion's location before purchasing a service. *There will be no refund because of location.*
2. Contact the Stallion owner in advance to ask about other costs and fees that may be due to the Stallion owner as part of the service. You will find a link to each Stallion owner within the Stallion's listing, and we recommend that you contact the owner by email to be sure of any additional fees that will be due.

How do I purchase a breeding?

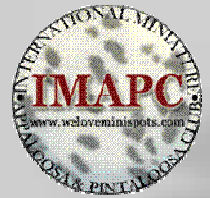
To purchase a donated breeding to one of these fine Appaloosa and Pinto stallions, please do the following:

1. Check for the current bid on the Stallion service that you are interested in on our Stallion Auction page. ([here](#))
2. Complete and submit the Offer of Bid from the Website. Only members in good standing at the Registries will be considered for this program.
3. **PRINT AND SUBMIT** the form in this package **WITH YOUR SIGNATURE** to the Incentive Program Director to complete the bid process.
4. **REMEMBER --** your posted bid is based on your internet bid date and the time it is received. However, no bid will be considered completed until you print the form from this package and mail to the Incentive Program Director with your signature. **BE CAREFUL: At the end of the bidding on February 28, 2010, your signed form MUST HAVE BEEN RECEIVED by the Incentive Program Director to be considered a VALID BID.**

NOTICE OF TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The **3rd Annual Spotted Stallion Service Auction** is a means for the International Miniature Appaloosa and Pinto Club to raise funds for the promotion of registered, quality Appaloosa and Pinto patterned miniature horses. To ensure the smooth administration of this auction and for the protection of the stallion, stallion owner and mare owner, all parties involved are subject to the following terms and conditions.

1. These Terms and Conditions apply to the purchase and bidding on any service ("Service") to any stallion ("Stallion") showing in the auction, and will be strictly adhered to by both the Stallion Owner or Agent and the Mare Owner or Agent.



2. No purchase/bid will be considered complete until a Offer of Purchase/ Bid form is received by the IMAPC Incentive Program Director.
3. The purchase of any donated Service is being done with the intention of producing an Appaloosa or Pintaloosa patterned foal.
4. All donated Services offered are being made publicly available to Registered Mares and No bids will be accepted by a Registry member who is suspended or has been expelled from a Registry.

This fee is the payment for the donated Service ONLY. All other costs that may be charged are subject to private negotiation and payment to the stallion owner. These services may include: grazing, mare care, shipping, collection fees, clean culture(s), confirmation of pregnancy, vaccinations, etc.

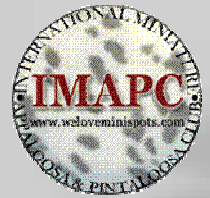
5. The IMAPC Board of Directors will arbitrate any disputed contracts, and their decisions will be final.
6. If a Stallion whose donated service has been purchased, is not able to fulfill the service, due to illness, death, gelding or sale, the Mare Owner will be offered the following options:
 - monies can be applied to another available stallion service, or
 - a full refund of your purchase price—if payment has been received (minus any PayPal fees charged at the time of submission)
 - If due to an unfortunate event, your Mare is unable to be bred to the stallion whose donated service you purchased, you may submit a substitute mare to the Stallion owner.
7. Mares must arrive with a clean culture, current negative Coggins, Brand Inspection (if required) and Health Certificate and be up to date with all vaccinations, dewormings and hoof care.

*****IMAPC advises all mare owners to insure the mare while out for servicing. Also, please inquire of the stallion owner about any specific vaccinations that may be recommended for the area where the Service will be provided, i.e. West Nile Virus, Strangles, etc.**

WINNING BIDS:

On March 1, 2010, each person placing the winning bid will be contacted by email and telephone to notify them of their winning bid. The WINNER HAS 24 HOURS TO PAY IMAPC FOR THE WINNING BID.

Should the payment not be made by PayPal, Certified Check sent via Overnight service or Wire Transfer to IMAPC, the 2nd highest bidder will be offered the service at their bid price. This will continue in 24 hour increments until IMAPC receives payment for the service.



IMPAC OFFERS A LIVE FOAL GUARANTEE: **24 hours, stand & nurse**

In the event your resulting foal does not survive 24 hours, your vet certified death report must be submitted to the IMAPC Incentive Program Director, to exercise a breed back.
